Organizing effort (50%)

Effort for organizing photos. Less effort gets more points.

Similarity (50%)

Similarity between organizing result and what you want. More similar, more points.

Lazy



- Just take photos. No effort!
- Sort photos by date taken



- It's difficult to find photos
- Seldom view photos





Use other apps to automatically organize





Smart



- Less effort after uploading
- Basic categories: People/Place/Things



- You have to find a suitable app first
- Results may differ from what you want





Use the Photos app to create albums





Hardworking



All the categories are what you want



 More effort. You need to find photos first, then organize





Import photos to a computer to organize





Careful



- All the categories are what you want
- Backup photos to the computer



 Complicated steps. Import to computer→Organize→Backup

Use tags to organize photos: Just two steps, select photos and add tags.

Similarity 50

Customized tags: All the categories are what you want.








Adding tags is as easy as using Instagram
















Add Tags before Taking Photos



Photos are well organized after taken








The system automatically categorize photos by tags


Use Tag List to View Photos

Select a tag and view the photos s






Use Tag List to View Photos



Flexible management. View your favorite photos at any time






Create favorite tags, edit or delete any tags

We suggest you to use a QNAP NAS to backup your photos and tags


Use NAS to Keep Precious Moments




3 steps to back up






Photo Station 5.6 – Read / Write Metadata
