The Brand-new Recognize Engine

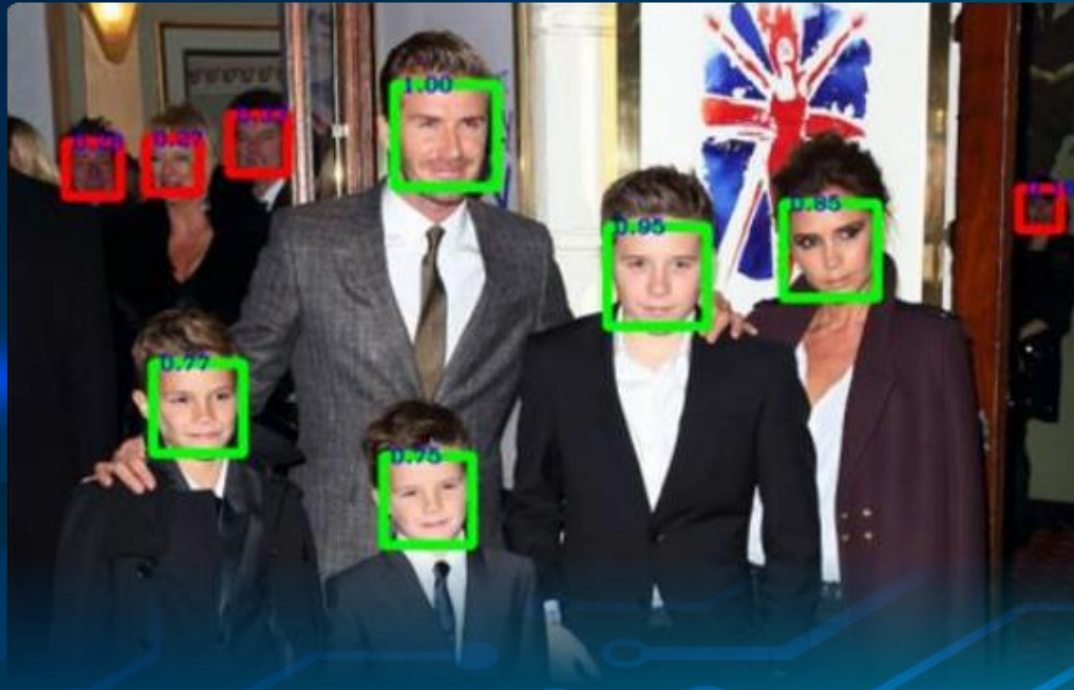
- Support QTS 4.4.1 and later
- Support QNAP NAS with Intel, AMD and ARM 64 CPU
- Recommended to use with more than 4GB RAM
- Must enable "Multimedia Services" before it is installed
- Container Station will be installed automatically

Note: More than 4GB RAM is necessary for NAS with ARM 64 CPU.

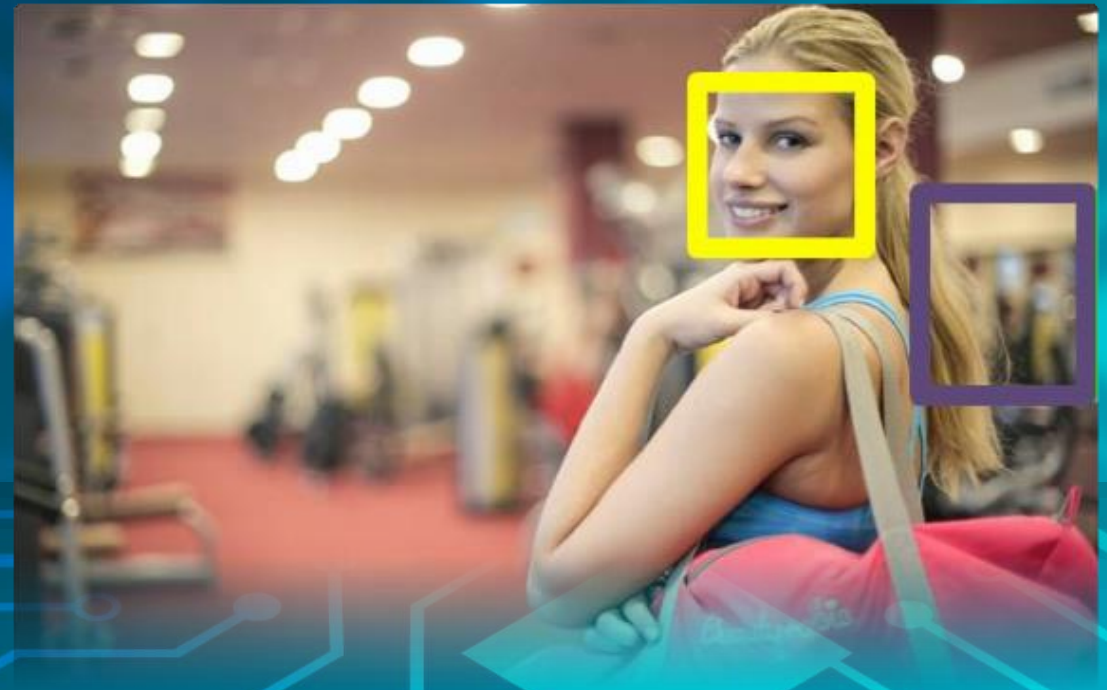

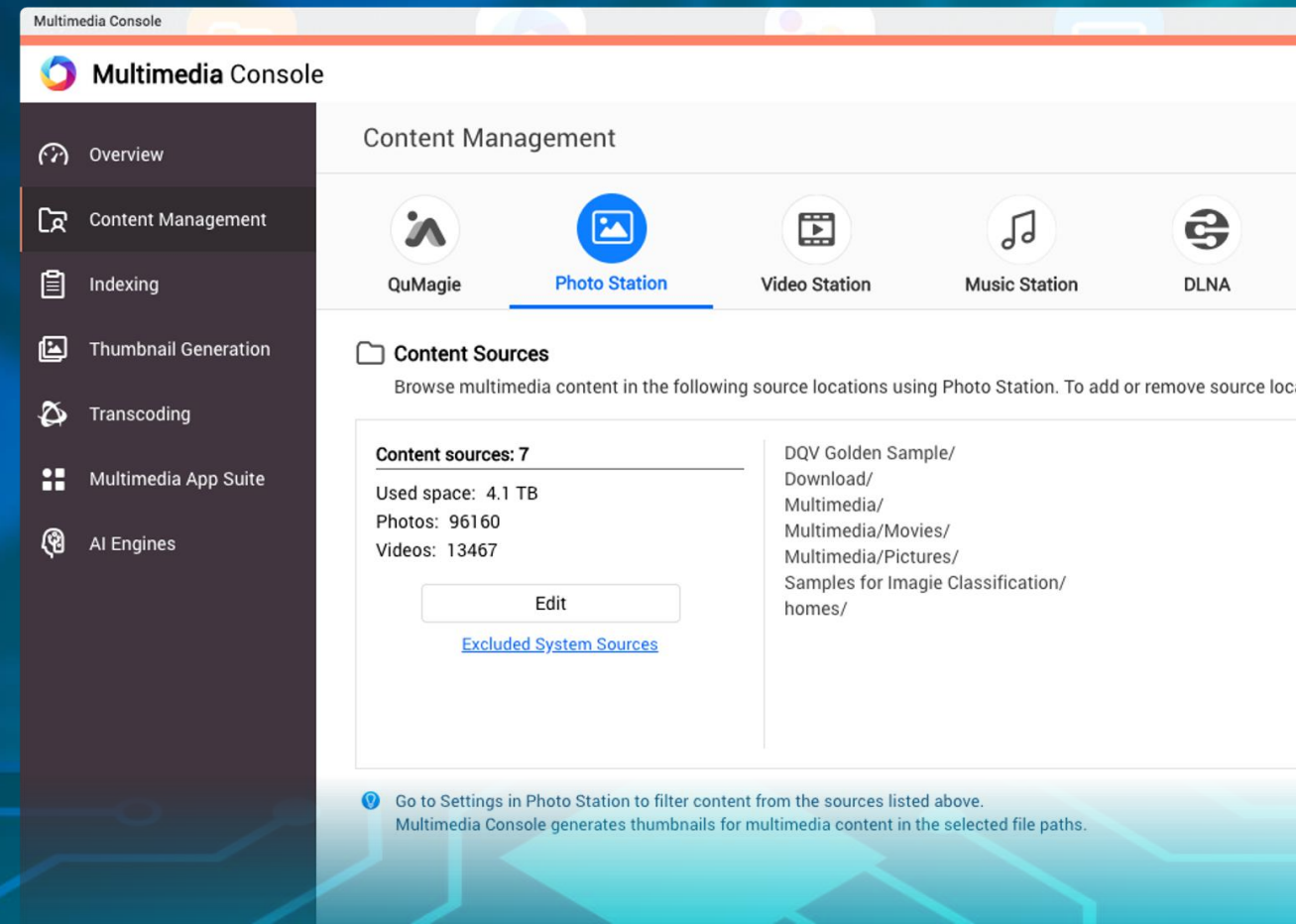
Set Content Sources

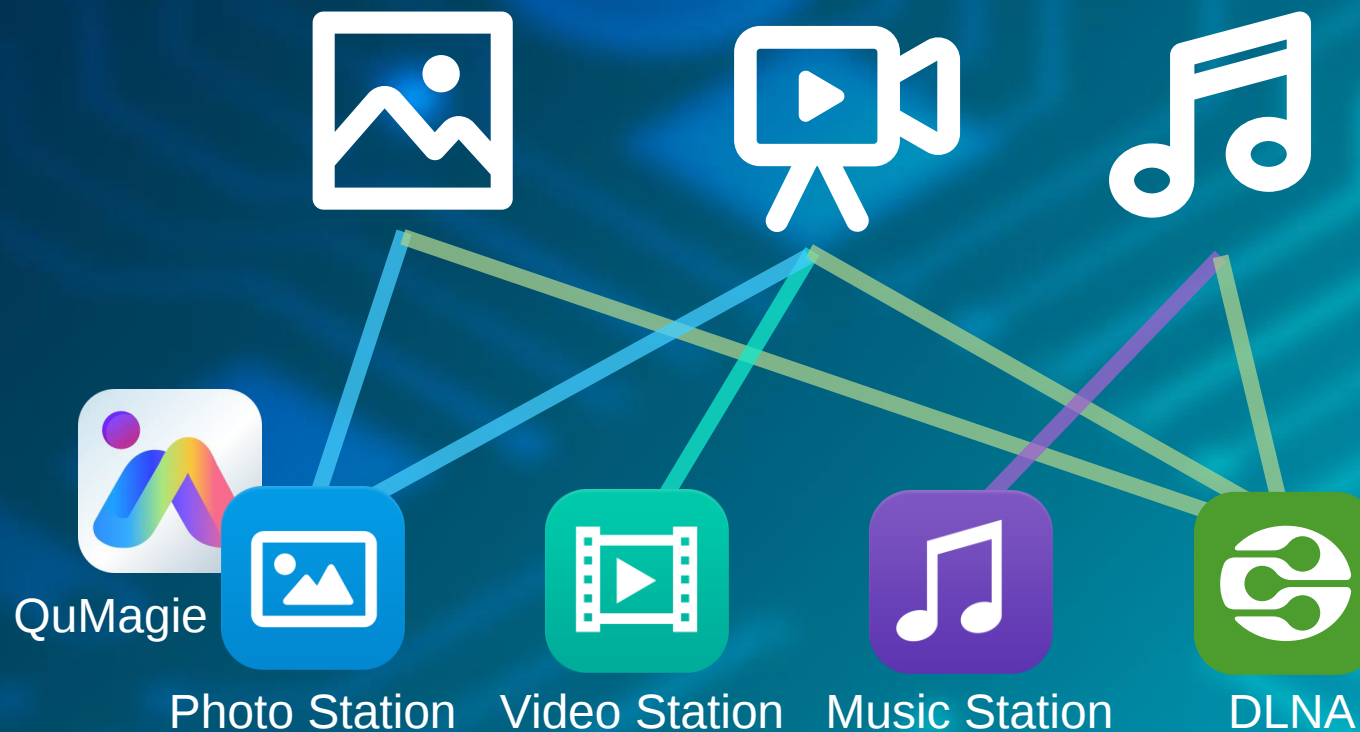

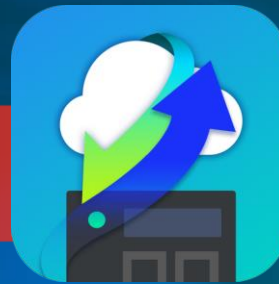

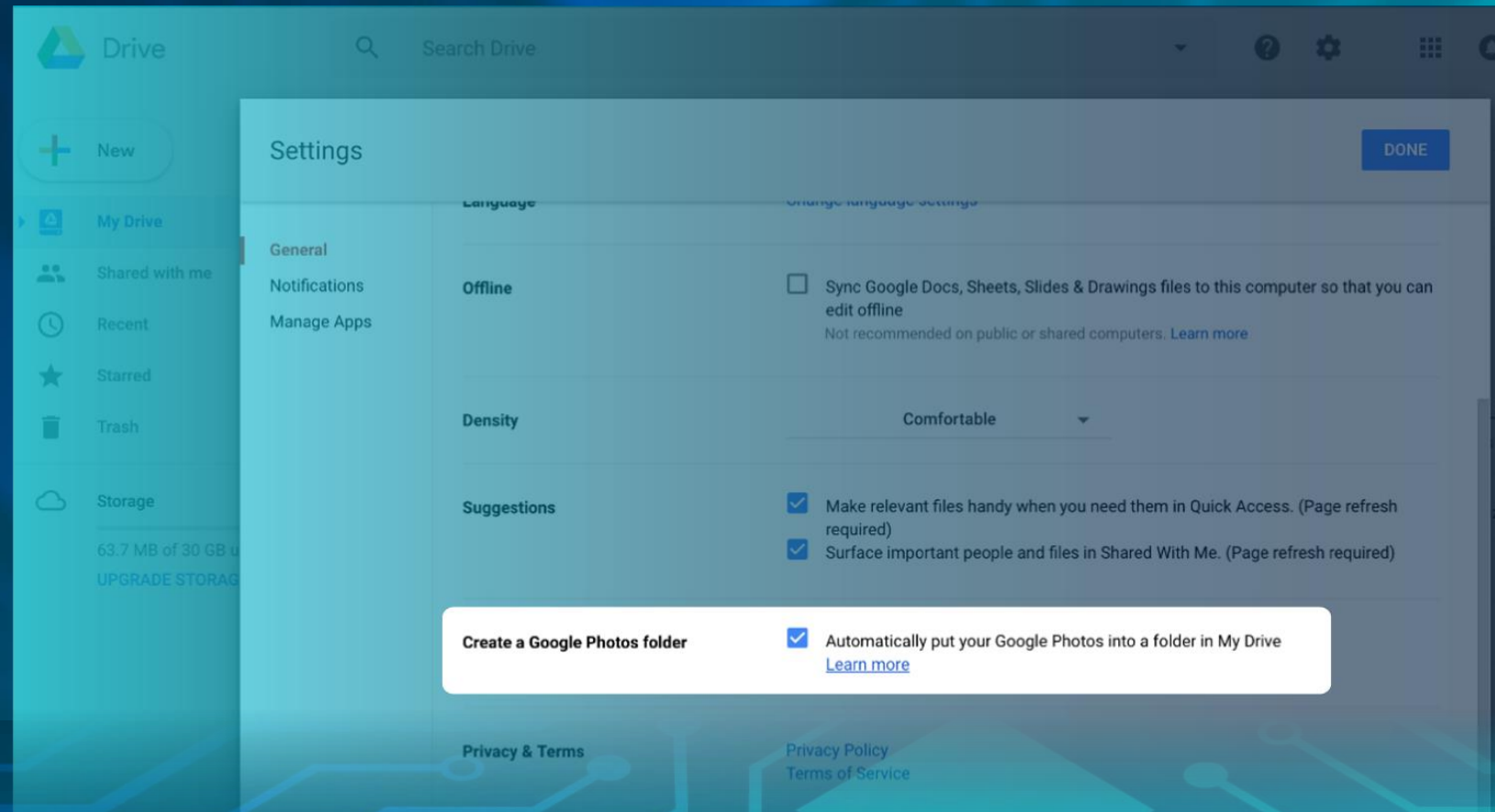
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Step 1

Enable Google to automatically put Google Photos into a folder in My Drive



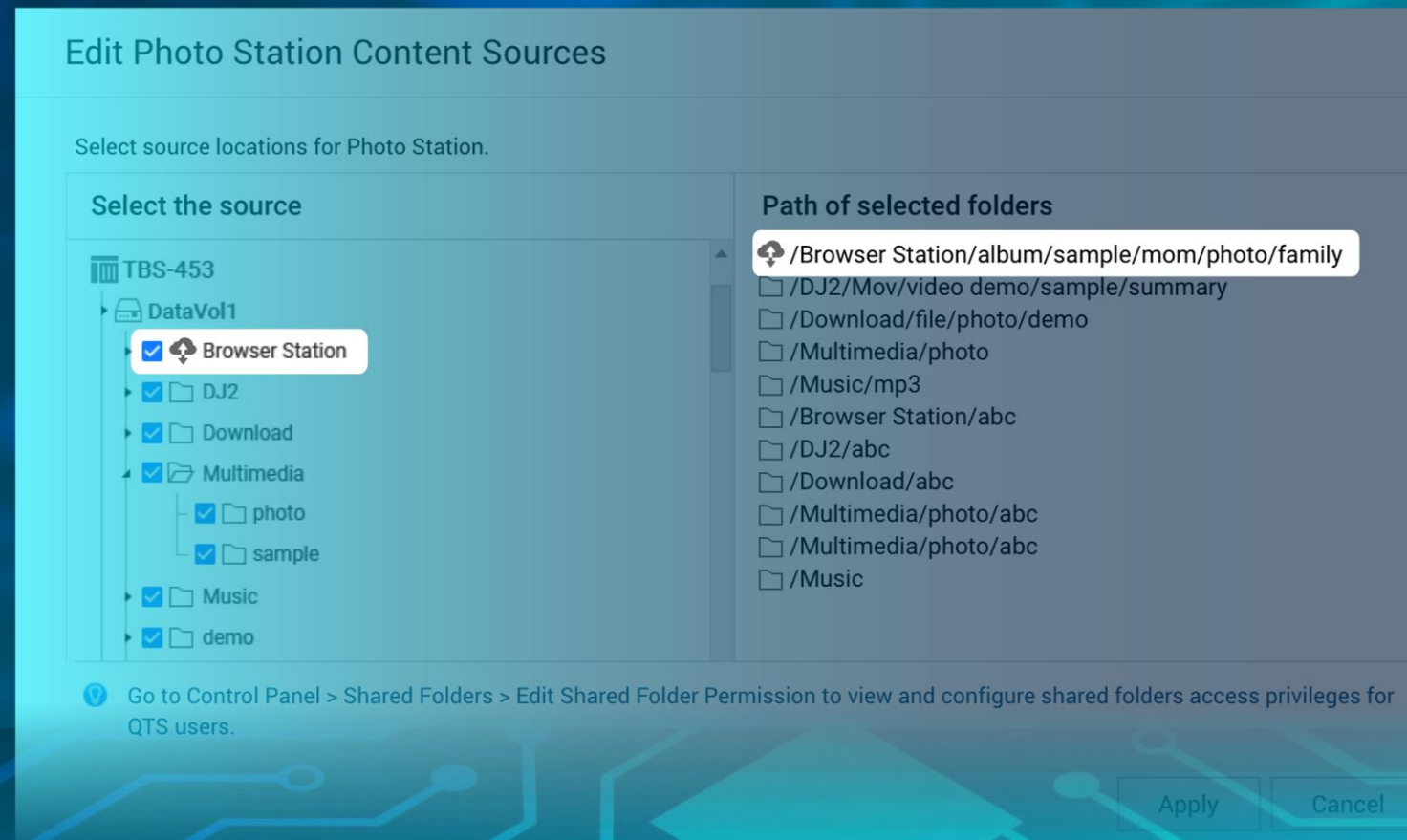
New Feature

Set the CacheMount Volume as a content source, and you can browse contents on the cloud in multimedia applications.



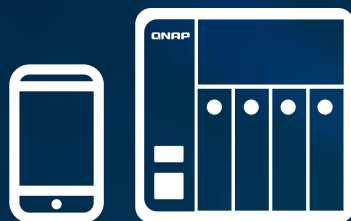

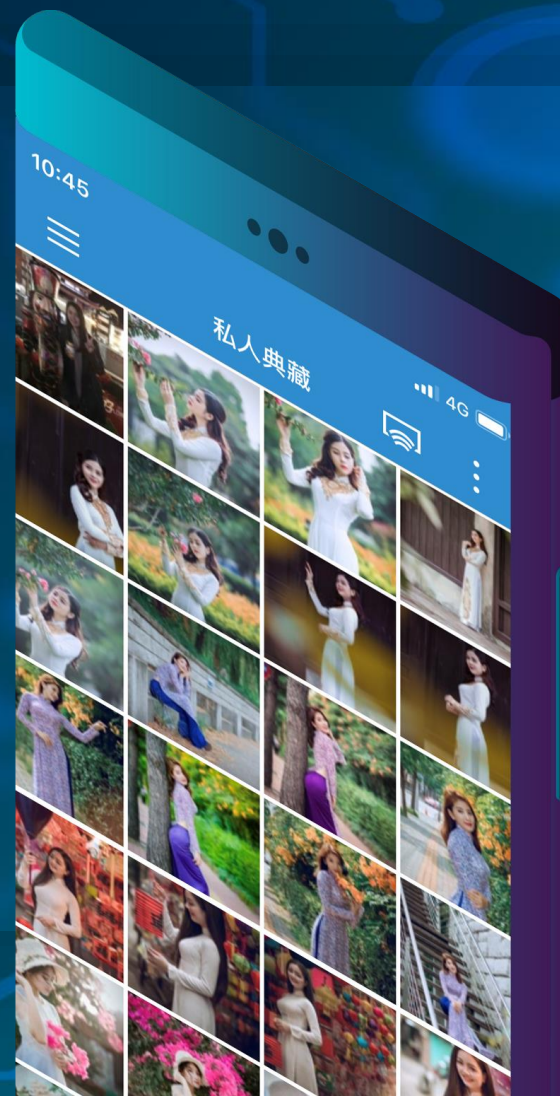
